overwhelmed as they received the equipment.

"Centralized kasi yung paggamit ng nebulizer dito, kailangan dumaan muna sa CRM (Center for Respiratory Medicine)," Asst. Chief Nurse Liezl Llena said. "It will really be a big help to the (Pedia) ward."

Nebulizers are used as treatment for asthma and Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), the most common diseases diagnosed in children.

"This is just the start. We will be back to give more," Prof. Carlos concluded.

The UST Hospital Pediatrics ward houses 30-40 patients.


On its 20th year, UST JOBS continues to provide strong manpower to the world, with this year's theme, "Exemplifying the Thomasian Identity for World Class Employability".


